2004 Pretty Sally Cabernet Shiraz, Victoria (\$16); Classy herb/plum notes add lilt to black cherry/violet notes. Traces of tobacco and spice. Juicy, but with good structure and not much tannin. There is a distinctly cool-climate aroma underneath this superb “little” wine that offers sensational drinkability and should be better in a year or two.
