Dark, rich and juicy, yet very elegant with soft tannins. Spicy cherry with chocolate, vanilla and oak. It’s a “pretty” Cab, offering first growth Napa quality & style at a great price!

Combines the best of Cab & Shiraz, fruity with nice tannins. Amazing quality at this price point.

Tasting Notes: Shiraz

Our “inky” wine with wonderful dark color. Juicy, with bright ripe blackberry, plum and cassis, along with pepper, roasted coffee and lovely wildflowers. A cool climate shiraz, offering lots of bright flavors in an elegant (old world, lower alcohol) style.

Tasting Notes Sauvignon Blanc:

Intense wine with round juicy flavors of orchid fruit (white peach, pears, ripe apple). Has lots of structure, nice acidity and the flavors go on forever (long finish).

Food pairing Recommendations:

Cabernet, CabShiraz & Shiraz:

All red meat, including lamb
 Any dish with spices
 (curry, chili, BBQ, pepper, etc)
 Cheese

Sauvignon Blanc:

Any sea food
 Oysters
 Citric based dishes (lemon, apple, orange)
 Tomato sauces

Origin of Name:

Vineyard is next to the now called Pretty Sally Hills, in Victoria Region, just north of Melbourne. Pretty Sally (AKA Mrs. Sally Smith) operated one of the more successful brothels north of Melbourne during Australia’s Gold Rush of the mid-1800s, in the land of Ned Kelly.

Other information:

- We follow organic vineyard management practices, as we only use organic compost and work hard to avoid the use of chemical treatments.
- Winemaker is one of top 10 winemakers in Australia, John Ellis, was founding winemaker at Rosemount Estate (1974) and previously winemaker at Yalumba.
- Our climate is maritime, benefiting from morning fog, great sun all day and daily afternoon breezes. Superb conditions for making old world style, elegant wines.¹
